



Scoutmaster and Assistant Scoutmaster Specific Training; April 18, 2015

The course is intended to provide troop leadership with the information and tools they need to lead successful Boy Scout troops. It is one of the two face-to-face training courses required for Boy Scout Assistant Scoutmasters and Scoutmasters. This one-day session will provide leaders with information and tools needed to help their troop. •

Participants are encouraged to wear a Scout uniform shirt. All participants should complete online [Youth Protection](#) Training and [This is Scouting](#) prior to attending this course.

Training will consist of one Saturday – April 18, 2015, 7:45am to 1:45 pm, at Heckrodt Wetland Preserve, 1305 Plank Rd, Menasha, WI 54952. We be in the Lopas building, about 100 ft or so down the trail from the main building. Arrive by 7:45am, Course starts at 8 am sharp. Coffee and other drinks as well as snacks will be provided.

Introduction to Outdoor Leader Skills combined with Outdoor Leaders Skills for Webelos Leaders; May 29-30, 2015 in conjunction with the Gathering Waters Spring Camporee. All participants will receive training credit for both courses.

Working as patrols, this hands-on course provides adult leaders the practical outdoor skills they need to lead Scouts in the out-of-doors. Upon completion, leaders should feel comfortable teaching Scouts the basic skills required to obtain the First Class rank and the Webelos outdoor activity badges. The course fee is **\$20.00**. You will be camping with your Troop/Den. Training will start at 7:30 PM on 5/29. It will resume at 7:40 on 5/30 and continue until lunch. You will eat lunch with your unit then return to training for the afternoon. We will attend the Scout's Own and Campfire with the Camporee. Plan on having a couple of training elements between Scout's Own, Supper, and the Campfire.

While there is no fee, a separate registration is required so we can have appropriate staff and materials for the course. As above – select the [Introduction to Outdoor Leader Skills](#) course on 5/29. You may mail a check or stop by the Council Office and pay with cash. Call the Council Office if you have payment questions.

Note: While it is beneficial, you are not required to take the two courses in succession or even from the same District.
