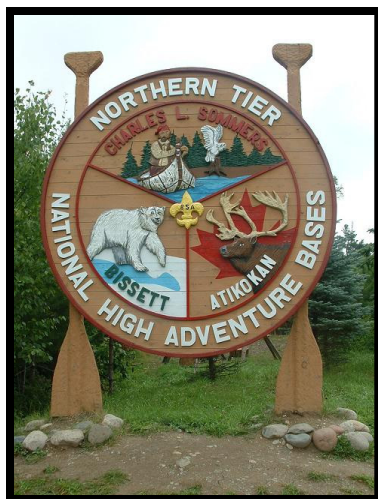


## Bay-Lakes Council contingent to Northern Tier 2009



Crews are being formed for the Bay-Lakes Council's 3<sup>rd</sup> annual contingent to the Northern Tier National High Adventure Base at Ely, MN in 2009. Individuals or groups of two or more are encouraged to sign-up for this exciting high adventure trek into the Boundary Waters Canoe Area Wilderness in northern Minnesota.

This fully-outfitted canoe trip will allow crews to spend eight days and seven nights camping in the pristine wilderness of the Boundary Waters. You'll paddle across beautiful lakes, portage through forests of virgin timber and see fantastic wildlife. You can also try your luck at catching abundant walleyes, northern pike, smallmouth bass and lake trout! Not too many things beat a great shore lunch of fresh caught fish!

The trip includes all crew gear, lodging before and after your trip, meals, two council contingent quick-dry t-shirts and the opportunity for a great experience at one of the BSA's three national high adventure bases! A Northern Tier staff member, called an Interpreter, joins your crew and accompanies you for the duration of your trek - A valuable member of your crew, to be sure! Secure your spot today!!
