

7 MOST ASKED QUESTIONS / CUB SCOUT WORLD, ROKILIO SUMMER CAMP

1- How old do the boys need to be to attend Cub Scout World, Camp Rokilio summer resident camp? May Tiger Cubs attend?

Answer: 2nd grade in the fall....**TIGER CUBS MAY NOT ATTEND!** They may attend Core Camps, Community Cub Scout Day Camp, or any of the family camps offered. Boys entering 6th grade in the fall must attend **Boy Scout camps.**

2- Do people over 40 need Part B of the Annual Health and Medical Record form?

Answer: Only Parts A and C are required for all youth and adults **no matter the age of the participant.** Forms are available at the Center for Scouting or on our web site at www.baylakesbsa.org.

3- How many adults are needed to attend camp with the Cub Scout pack?

Answer: Ratio of adults to youth is 4/1....3/1 is better. Two-deep leadership is required.

4- May a boy camp out with a parent if the building is filled to capacity?

Answer: Yes. Extra adults may camp out as well. However, there is a limit to how many campers the camp staff can provide program and dining hall seating to in any given session.

5- May adults take turns sharing a spot at camp if they cannot attend the entire time?

Answer: Yes. Please let the office personnel know at the time of check-in.

6-May we add participants right up to the time of our camp session?

Answer: Yes! However, there is no guarantee of receiving a t-shirt after May 20th. Please check with the Center for Scouting first to be sure there is an open spot.

7- When can a Cub Scout pack sign up for 2010?

Answer: The first opportunity for Cub Scout packs to register for the 2010 summer camping season is at the Cub Scout leader College Training. Please check upcoming events for the location and time of this event.
