Silver Beaver Selection Guidelines

When reviewing applications for the Silver Beaver Award, the committee takes into consideration the guidelines listed below. How an individual measured up to these standards, along with a total overall contribution to Scouting and the respect earned by his or her peers, weighed on the final selection of recipients.

1. Must be a registered Scouter 21 years of age or older.
2. Must have rendered noteworthy service to exceptional character to boyhood within the Bay-Lakes Council territory. Recognition of noteworthy service might take the form of a single plan or a variety of activities which vitally affect the lives of a large number of boys, or service given to a small group of boys over an extended period of time.
3. The candidate should have experience in service to youth outside of Scouting.
4. The service provided must be regarded as outstanding or distinctive beyond normal expectations.
5. The candidate should have a record of service, reputation and standing in their community.
