Let me know if I can help you set up an adventure for your crew or the older Scouts in your troop. I hope you can make it!

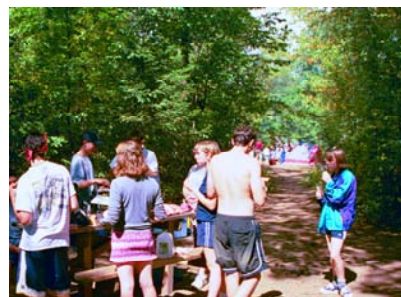

Frequently Asked Questions

Wolf River Adventures for Venturing Crews & Older Scouts



What are the Wolf River Adventures?

These are Venturing and older Scout summer programs based at Camp Gardner Dam. Examples are canoe camping in northern Wisconsin, sea kayaking and biking in Door county, whitewater kayaking, rock climbing, mountain biking, sailing, black powder rifle and more. Ages are 14 and up for most programs.

What about the staff?

This is a brand new staff of young adults ages 18 through 25 that only focus on older youth high adventure programs.

When?

These summer programs start on June 22 and end on August 9.

I have a small group, where would we stay?

Small groups can stay in a special camping area for Venturing Crews where you could share the site with other Venturing Crews.

What is the smallest size group that you can accommodate?

One youth under the age of 21 and one adult over the age of 21 is the smallest group size.

What equipment do I need to bring?

Only personal equipment such as sleeping bags and clothing.

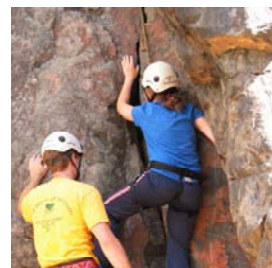
Who prepares the meals in camp?

The meals are prepared by the camp cook staff and are served in the dining room in upper Heckrodt.

We are having a problem finding an adult leader who can stay in camp for the week?

The Bay-Lakes Council is offering a single week of Provisional Camp where youth can come and adult leadership is provided by the council. This week is June 29 – July 5.

What is the cost of a week of these programs?

The cost is \$250.00 for youth participants and \$200.00 for participating adults over the age of 21 for sign-up by May 2. The fee is \$75.00 for non-participating adults.

Some of the youth in my unit may not be able to afford quite that much, what can we do?

The Bay-Lakes Council does offer camperships for youth who may need financial assistance. Forms are available on the council website at www/baylakesbsa.org.

How soon do we need to sign-up?

Space is limited. Early sign-up will give the best chance of having the dates and programs that you want.
